## **DECserver 200 Documents**

These documents arrive with the DECserver 200 hardware unit:

DECserver 200 Hardware Installation/Owner's Guide DECserver 200 Identification Card

The *DECserver 200 Hardware Installation/Owner's Guide* should be kept with the DECserver 200 unit. The *DECserver 200 Identification Card* moves from person to person as described on the card itself.

The following manuals and cards arrive with the DECserver 200 software. The documents are in two loose–leaf binders: Volume 1 and Volume 2.

The person who installs the DECserver 200 software needs the software installation guide. After the software installation, the binders would be accessible to the server manager and to the persons using interactive terminals that are connected to DECserver 200 ports.

A Software Performance Report (SPR), warranty information, and cover letters may also accompany your DECserver 200 software.

You can order a user documentation kit for each person who uses an interactive terminal at a DECserver 200 port. It contains the following manuals:

DECserver 200 User's Guide Terminal Server User's Reference Card

Extensive on-line documentation is included on the software media:

On-line HELP (consisting of tutorial HELP and reference HELP) DECserver 200 Release Notes

When the server is initialized (booted), on-line HELP is available for anyone using a terminal on the server. The person with server management responsibility should read the release notes. The *DECserver 200 Software Installation Guide* tells you how to print the release notes.

## **Tutorial and Reference Manuals**

Tutorial documentation describes concepts and presents step-by-step instructions on how to use the features offered by the server. Initially, you should read these books chapter by chapter to learn how to carry out a task or series of tasks. For most readers, the *DECserver 200 Management Guide* is a tutorial manual.

Reference documentation, on the other hand, is organized to make information easy to look up. Most readers do not read a reference manual chapter by chapter. The reference guides provide details about the commands you use to carry out the tasks discussed in the tutorial manuals. The *Terminal Server Commands and Messages* is an example of a reference manual.

## **Audiences for DECserver 200 Documents**

An audience is a person or group of people for whom a manual or card is written. The documentation that you receive with your software media addresses the following audiences:

- Terminal user uses an interactive terminal attached to a DECserver 200 port. Terminal users have access to nonprivileged server commands.
- Server manager manages a DECserver 200 system. The server manager has access to privileged server commands.
- Software installer installs the server software and the LAT service node software (if required) on a load host. The installer also configures new servers in the load host node database.
- Network manager manages the local area network of the LAT network.

Because the *DECserver 200 Hardware Installation/Owner's Guide* is not sent with the software, the hardware installer is not discussed in this guide.

Note that more than one of these audience definitions may apply to a single person. For example, the network manager may also be the server manager for one or more servers.

You should read the DECserver 200 documentation in the sequence suggested for your audience classification. The following figures are flow charts for each audience.













## How To Order Documents

This section provides all the information you need to order additional documents. The ordering procedure you use depends on:

- Whether you are a customer or a Digital employee

#### RSX-11-M-PLUS Software Documentation Kit

The order number for the DECserver 200 RSX-11-M-PLUS documentation kit is QRZ07-GZ. This kit contains the same manuals as the VMS documentation kit except that the RSX-11M-PLUS kit contains *DECserver 200 Software Installation* (*RSX-11M-PLUS*) instead of the VMS version.

#### **Micro/RSX Software Documentation Kit**

The order number for the DECserver 200 Micro/RSX documentation kit is QYZ07-GZ. This kit contains the same manuals as the VMS documentation kit except that the Micro/RSX kit contains *DECserver 200 Software Installation* (*Micro/RSX*) instead of the VMS version.

#### **ULTRIX-32 Software Documentation Kit**

The order number for the DECserver 200 ULTRIX -32 documentation kit is QA-VDEAA-GZ. This kit contains the same manuals as the VMS documentation kit except that the ULTRIX-32 kit contains *DECserver 200 Software Installation* (*ULTRIX-32*) instead of the VMS version.

#### DECserver 200 User's Documentation Kit

The order number for the DECserver 200 User's Documentation kit is QA-VDEAB-GZ. The kit contains the following manuals:

- DECserver 200 User's Guide
- Terminal Server User's Reference Card
