What's new for the NAS Products

Beginning with this release of the Software Products Library, the NAS Packages component products will not ship on separate NAS discs within the Software Products Library, but can be found on the Software Products Library discs themselves.

The NAS base kits (including the group license table) and NAS documentation are delivered inline on the Software Products Library. The NAS component product kits can be obtained as a part of the Software Product Library or as separate component kits.
