HARDWARE COMMITTEE MINUTES:

There was a meeting of the hardware committee 11/11/82 in the 5M conference room at 6:30pm. The following members were in attendance: Barry Lewis. Steve Hessel, Dave Vanderwater, Larry Robertson, Mark Hoddap, Phil Gray and Rick Walker.

It was reported that Nic Lyons is no longer active in the club so Rick Walker volunteered to take over the newsletter.

Dave reported on the IO/4 status. The boards have been half loaded by Will Beckett. Dave has written a test program which will test the parallel ports and some RS-232 functions. At the present time, the 20mA current loop circuitry will not be tested.

20 Disc Controller boards are on order by the club, but none have been ordered from CCS.

28 Memory boards are on order by the club, but none have been ordered.

30 Dress Panels have been ordered and colors are now being selected. The CAT Video board was discussed as a future club offering and it was decided that the CAT may be overkill for many systems. The club will still pursue the CAT, but will also look for a simpler board to emulate a terminal.
