>dual serial I/O port - can be configured as a dual RS 232 or a single RS 232 and a 20 or 60 ma current loop

>8253 triple timer - all timers available to user if not using RS 232 port

>parallel input port - can be used for keyboard interface (has optional repeat-key capability

>dual software driven tape interface - able to support any standard >board supports interrupts
