Switch Requirements

This section describes some special requirements for the QLogic SANbox FC switches.

Installing the Switch Into an Existing Fabric

If you are installing firmware version 5.0.0.31 on any switch in the fabric then all switches in the fabric must be using firmware version 5.0.0.31. Sun does not support mixing firmware version 5.0.0.31 with earlier firmware version 2.x and version 4.x. Upgrade any QLogic or Sun StorEdge Network 2-Gbit FC switches to firmware version 5.0.0.31. Use the upgrade process described in patch 119553, which is available from <http://sunsolve.sun.com>.

Firmware Requirement

The minimum firmware version that is compatible with the QLogic SANbox FC switches is 5.0.0.31.

Management Software Requirement

The QLogic SANbox FC switches must be managed by the QLogic SANSurfer Switch Manager software minimum version 5.00.05.

Bugs

This section provides information about bugs filed against this product.

Zoneset Creation Failure When Using SMI-S

Bug 6383668 — When you create zonesets using the Storage Management Initiative Specification (SMI-S), the zoneset creation might intermittently fail, causing a CIM_ERR_FAILED error to display.

Workaround — Try the zoneset creation process again.
