## **Problem**

There have been several reports that listings and labels printed in ZIP CODE order would be printed out of sequence after updating any zip code. The changes below should keep the problem from occuring.

## **Solution**

To correct a disk on which the problem has already occured you will need to make the program changes, then delete and reenter any items printed out of sequence.

- Backup your diskette(s) and make the following changes on the Backup diskette.
  In BASIC load the program by typing LOAD"MLS".
  Make the following corrections.
  LINE CHANGES (Retype the entire line or refer to the Edit section of your owners manual)

   Type SAVE"MLS" to save the changes in the program.
