1. Enter the following program in BASIC.

- 6. When the Mailing List menu appears, press the BREAK key.
- 7. When the screen shows "READY", type: GOTO 5200 and press ENTER.
- 8. The system will examine your data files and retrieve, re-sort and index all the valid data found. When this process is complete, the Mailing List Menu will appear. Press the @ key to exit the program immediately.
- 9. Make BACKUP copies of your "recovered" disks. Examine the data carefully before copying over your original disks. If the data is not correct, try the operation again.
