Problem

After one year of running Inventory Management, the suggested order list is supposed to be automatically switched to the zero base ordering. Instead it is two months off.

Solution

The problem is corrected by following the steps listed below.

- 1. Backup the diskette(s) and make the changes on the Backup copy of the program.
- 2. In BASIC load the program by typing LOAD"ORDER/BAS".
- 3. Make the following corrections:
