Problem

In the Prepare Checks section of the Model II payroll program there is a problem. If you enter (choose to prepare a check for) an employee number that is greater than the total number of employees in your Payroll system the number entered will replace that of the employee currently displayed.

Solution

The problem is corrected by following the steps listed below.

1. Backup the diskette(s) and make the changes on the Backup copy of the program.
2. In BASIC load the program by typing LOAD"INPUT".
3. Make the following corrections:

CHANGES (Retype the line or refer to the Edit section of the owners manual)

Old Line: 510 IFCF=0 THEN N=VAL(IN\$)-EO ELSE IFCF<>5 THEN 500

New Line: 510 IFCF<>5 THEN IFCF<>0 THEN 500 ELSE C=VAL(IN\$)-EO:
IFC<LORC>LOF(3) THEN 500 ELSE N=C

Old Line: 520 IFN<LORN>LOF(3) THEN 500 ELSE IFCF=0 THEN N1=.....

New Line: 520 IFN<LORN>LOF(3) THEN 500 ELSE IFCF=0 THEN N1=INSTR(C1\$,CHR\$(N))

4. Type SAVE"INPUT" to save the changes in the program.
5. At TRSDOS Ready, make a backup copy of the corrected diskette.
