Solution

The following patches will correct the problem:

Be sure the date at the bottom of the startup screen is 05/24/82. If not, be sure to obtain and do all previous patches.

PATCH SCRIPSIT/SYS R=163 E=196 F=F7F7 C=19D6

PATCH SCRIPSIT A=D626 F=ØØØØØØØØØØØØØØØØØØØØØØØØØØØØØ C=ØEØ1CB5F28Ø43AFDDD4FCD35F9

PATCH SCRIPSIT A=D633 F=ØØØØ C=C1C9

After applying these patches, apply the following to change the date in the STARTUP screen:

PATCH STARTUP A=E40E F=B0B5AFB2B4 C=B0B5AFB2B7
