Problem

Any program compiled under RSBASIC Compiler and operating under RUNBASIC or RUNTIME BASIC can develop a problem when processing ISAM files. This problem will be manifested as an unexpected termination of the program and a return to TRSDOS READY status without displaying any error messages. The problem is caused when RUNBASIC (or RUNTIME BASIC) calls the module, RSBASIC/LIO, which handles the deletion of ISAM records. When deleting a particular group of ISAM records, the module fails to complete the deletion process, which causes RUNBASIC (or RUNTIME BASIC) to fail with a subsequent return to TRSDOS.

Solution

At TRSDOS READY, apply the following patch to correct the problem.

If the user has the RUNTIME BASIC disk($26-47\emptyset6$), the above patch should be applied to it also.
