

MUSICWARE products currently available from Sequential include the Model 964 SEQUENCER: It lets you record 8 separate sequences with 6 independent tracks per sequence to build your own songs; and the Model 910 EXPANSION SOFTWARE FOR THE SIX-TRAK SYNTHESIZER: It offers programmable keyboard split and frontpanel screen programming, and it lets you create and save groups of 100 Six-Trak programs.
