


TAPUINO C64 TAPE EMULATOR



* By defect, the Tapuino is powered by commodore computer. If you prefer external power, you must change the jumper position on the pcb.

Connecting Tapuino

Turn off the Commodore before connecting or disconnecting the Tauino.



IMPORTANT: Do not connect the Tapuino to the Commodore and USB at the same time.

On PC:


Copy your favorite programs (only .tap files) on a microSD card. (You can copy folders too).

On TAPUINO:

Insert the microSD card with the .tap files in the rear slot and follow these steps for loading a file:



```




Press << Or >> to select the file

Press Shift + Run/Stop keys

on Commodore keyboard

File_name.tap
```




To make a tape copy:

1) Invert the signal:




2) Select the file name for recording:



Press  to start the record.

3) Loading the recorded file:



**Press Shift + Run/Stop keys
on Commodore keyboard**
